Health Care Products (12/31/2011)

TANF (1,422,000 members)

A family focused, Medicaid-managed health care product. This product is designed for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) population that consists primarily of low-income children and their mothers.

CHIP (262,000 members)

A managed health care product for uninsured children not eligible for Medicaid. This product is designed for the State Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) initiative.

SPD (242,000 members)

A managed health care product designed for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients. This population consists of low-income Seniors and People with Disabilities (SPD).

FamilyCare (74,000 members)

A managed health care product focused on uninsured adults and parents of CHIP or Medicaid-eligible children.

Medicare Advantage (24,000 members)

Medicare health plans focusing on low-income Medicare beneficiaries, consisting of regular Medicare plans and Special Needs Plans (SNPs) for dual-eligible beneficiaries with both Medicare and Medicaid
